The building, which is net zero carbon, will be opening its doors to pupils for the first time on September 5th, as the school welcomes its first cohort of pre-school and reception class children.

Educate Together Academy Trust currently run four other schools across the Southwest, offering their ethical 'Learn Together' curriculum alongside the National Curriculum and Early Years Framework.
